Harvestworks and Electronic Music Foundation (the Partnership) seek a full-time Project Manager to coordinate and oversee a multi-faceted capital planning process for a proposed Lower Manhattan electronic arts center.

The Project Manager will coordinate and advance all aspects of the planning process, acting as liaison with partners, service providers, consultants, legal counsel, real estate brokers, city officials, cultural leaders, and funding agencies. In addition, the Project Manager will manage the project timeline and budget, and ensure that funder-mandated compliance requirements are met.

The Project Manager will report to the responsible executives of the partnering organizations.

This is a one-year position with the possibility for continuation pending funding.

Responsibilities include:

- Develop RFPs, and identify, coordinate evaluation, and manage hiring of potential consultants, service providers, and other team members;
- Create and manage a project timeline that effectively coordinates inputs from various consultants, including business planning, real estate and architectural services, board development consultants, etc.
- Create project budget and oversee payments and record keeping.
- Create all necessary internal and external reports.

• Manage project compliance including monthly and quarterly reports to the Lower Manhattan Development Corporation, and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, as necessary.

Qualifications:

- Excellent written and oral communication, facilitation and presentation skills are essential
- Highly organized with ability to work both independently and in a team environment
- Proven project management skills; including experience with at least one capital project for a nonprofit organization
- Ability to represent the Partnership and the project in meetings with members of the public, private, and nonprofit sectors;
- Experience working with government-funded projects and related compliance, procurement, sub-contracting, and reporting requirements.
