AMENDMENT #7

This Amendment will provide clarification regarding the operation of the four (4) scaffolding stations during the abatement and deconstruction activities that remain at 130 Liberty Street. The movement and operation of these stations is currently defined on the basis of the building and abatement activities being performed simultaneously during the entire term of the 130 Liberty Street deconstruction program. It will not be necessary that the scaffolding stations remain in operation once abatement activities have been completed on the 11th floor of the building provided deconstruction is not in progress. This Amendment will comply with the existing provisions of the September 7, 2005 Ambient Air Monitoring Program Plan as well as all subsequent Amendments to this Plan. During abatement operations, silica monitors will be co-located with the four (4) scaffolding stations.

All four (4) monitoring locations currently in place atop building roofs adjacent to the 130 Liberty Street property and all four (4) ground level stations will remain in place during the balance of the building abatement and deconstruction process even if these processes are not performed simultaneously as is currently proposed.

Reason for Amendment:

The current approach to the movement and operation of scaffolding stations is based upon the understanding that building abatement and deconstruction processes would be performed simultaneously during the entire term of the project. Since the bulk of deconstruction work will resume only after most of decontamination work is complete, scaffolding stations now situated on the 15th floor of 130 Liberty Street would cease collecting samples upon completion of abatement on the 11th floor. Scaffold sampling will resume on commencement of active building deconstruction. The scope of the scaffold sampling shall be defined with consultation and approval by USEPA prior to commencement of active building deconstruction, including abatement of stairwells.

Sections of Air Monitoring Plan Affected:

No Plan sections affected as a result of this Amendment. This Amendment provides clarification language to Amendment # 5 (dated June 8, 2007) to the Ambient Air Monitoring Program Plan which revised Section 2.1, Network Design, On-site Scaffolding Elevated Stations and Section 2.3, Locations of Monitoring Stations.
